Dear Mr. Stephens:

The Federal Committee on Pest Control has reviewed the proposal submitted by you on February 11, 1968, involving aerial application of herbicides for brush control along the Malheo-Pelican POU pipeline.

The Committee did not object to the use of Picloram and 2,4-D with the Norbait thickenener, in view of unsatisfactory results from 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T on spruce on the right-of-way. We noted also that spraying would be limited to within 100 feet of streams, lakes or other bodies of water and would not be conducted if the wind were stronger than 5 miles per hour.
