1. Real Property Facilities Project, DD Form 1391, Post Request No. 20-69, covering aerial spraying of herbicide by helicopter for brush control along the Haines - Fairbanks POL pipeline from pipeline milepost 42.5 to 337.5 (all in Canada), is approved for contract accomplishment at a total cost of \$110,900 (\$109,400 funded) subject to approval of the Federal Committee on Pest Control and the Canadian government.

2. Special Instructions:

a. Reference Technical Specification TS-03: The word "road" is to be deleted.

b. TS-04: This paragraph is to be reworded to say: "south Canadian Border to north Canadian Border," to exclude Haines as a terminus point. This corresponds to the direction of increasing mileage shown in subparagraphs a thru d.

c. TS-10: This is to be reworded to reflect regulatory requirements of Canada.

d. TS-05: Changes are shown in red on the marked copy of Technical Specifications.

3. This headquarters will take the necessary action to obtain approval of the Federal Committee on Pest Control and the Canadian government as may be required.

4. General Instructions:

a. The cost of this project will be charged to Detail Account No. 9060.3200.

b. Approval date is the date of this correspondence.

c. This project will be reported in Repairs and Utilities Individual Projects Report, USARAL Form 5-13, in accordance with current instructions.
