This is to acknowledge your letter of April 20, 1968, requesting our comments on the use of a combination of Fenuron and Tordon instead of 2-4,D, 2-4.5,T for brush control purposes on the above mentioned right-of-way.

Neither of these materials is particularly toxic to fish even at several times the recommended rates of application. You may consider that the Department does not object to this proposal subject to the provisos that the mixing of spray materials and the washing of spray equipment is done in an area well removed from ditches or streams leading to fish bearing waters and that the material is not applied directly over fish bearing waters.
