Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge your letter of February 24, 1965, in which you request permission to use chemical for clearing vegetation along the Raines Fairbanks Pipeline within Canada.

Authority is herewith given to use Ertoran, applied by hand-generated spray nozzles, to spray the pipeline right-of-way, in the Yukon Territory, to a width of fifty feet and not closer than 500 feet from any stream or lake.

I appreciate being advised of the proposed use of such chemical.
