Dear Sir,

Reference your letter of December 7th and Plans and Specifications submitted for above, we have looked over your documents and have very little comment to make other than:

- (1) that we think your Plans and Specifications are completely adequate;
- (2) that we note that Canadian Contractors have been extended equal consideration in bidding;
- (3) that Canadian labour can be used on the work;
- (4) that Canadian materials will be used;
- (5) that the United States may be granted permission to use timber and gravel and other construction material on Crown lands and that a free permit would be issued by the Commissioner of the Yukon Territory for the above, subject to the observations contained in our letter of Nov.23.

(6) and that the United States will be responsible for the satisfactory cleaning up of any construction camps.
