I wish to thank you for your letter dated February 10th, 1955, concerning the access road shown on the plan of survey for this proposed Reserve. It is noted that the only land which will be sold to the Church authority is the one acre site upon which the Mission buildings are located, and that the road as surveyed will be excepted from this sale and reserved for the use of the general public, including the Church authorities and the Indians.

This is quite satisfactory, and you may therefore proceed to sell the one acre parcel of land to the Church authorities.
