roposed Reservation for rampagne Indians on the KMakshu River, Y.T. Your file: 166/30-5-0.

I have received your letter of the 2nd February 1955, which refers to the access road surveyed in connection with the one-acre Mission parcel situated within the above reserved area.

The only land which will be sold to the church authorities is the one-acre site upon which their Mission is actually erected.

Our purpose in excepting the access road from the land reserved for your Branch is to make sure that it is available to the Indians, the Church authorities and any of the general public who find occasion to use it.

This information will, I trust, clear up any uncertainty regarding the status of the road.
