- 1. Reference is made to telephone conference between Mr. Pelton(NFD) and Mr. Britton (CCE) on 18 March 1954.
- 2. The following list of projects in the FT-1955 MCA Execution Program for Alaska has been released from the provisions of OCE multiple teletype, file AMCMI-2103, dated 16 December 1953 and has been approved by the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-h, for execution in FT-195h. Contracts may be awarded as soon as plans, specifications, construction directives, and funding become available and all required clearances have been obtained. Construction directives, for projects that have not been authorized, will be issued by CCE when apportionment is approved by the Eureau of the Eudget.
