SUBJECT: APL Equipment Available for Transfer

TO: The Division Engineer

1. Transmitted herewith is a list of excess items of APL tanks, pumps and pipe reported available for transfer from French Morocco. It may be possible that some of these items would be required in connection with the Haines-Fairbanks Pipeline. These items are reported to be immediately available, and the current lead time under new procurement of some of the items would be anywhere from three (3) to six (6) months after placement of the order.

2. The items listed will be available for transfer on the basis of fair value less discounts applied to the sum of the prices shown, which are COMUS acquisition costs, plus 30 percent for handling costs and shipping charges to French Morocco. Handling and shipping costs from French Morocco to destination will also be paid by the recipient.

3. It is suggested that this list be reviewed to determine whether any of the items can be used in connection with the Haines-Fairbanks APL Pipeline.

4. The North Pacific Division Engineer is authorized to deal direct with the Mediterranean Division Engineer, APO 30, USAF, c/o Postmaster, New York, New York, or the East Atlantic District Engineer, APO 30, USAF, c/o Postmaster, New York, New York.
