I have your letter of December 30th relative to the area covered by Timber Sale X 53311 which is dated August 20th 1951, but unfortunately I find it difficult to exactly locate this on the maps I have, relative to the right-of-way for the Haines-Fairbanks Pipeline, and the site of # 2 pumping station at approximately Mile 48, Haines Cut-off road.

Is it possible for you to check this against the plans of the pipeline right-of-way and site of # 2 pumping station, and advise me if there is any overlapping?

Although under Order in Council 1071 of May 2nd, 1953 the British Columbia Government transferred the properties required for the pipeline this was, under sec 12, subject to the prior rights of third parties. As the sub-contractors will in all probability be commencing to clear the right-of-way and the site of # 2 station within the next month or so, I want to be very sure that there are no third parties involved in any way.
