Last fall Chief Parten Kane of the Champagne Band of Indians requested that an Indian Reserve be surveyed at the fishing station of the Champagne Indians on Klukshu River. The matter was discussed with J. Walcott D.L.S., who is familiar with the site and the conditions surrounding the request.

The site requested is on the Haines Cut-off road leading from the Alaska Highway to Haines, Alaska. Commencing at the point of intersection of the Haines Cut-off Road and Klukshu River, three-quarters of a mile upstream, the land for one quarter of a mile on the east side of the River to be included, and on the west side of the river the area lying between the Haines Cut-off Road and Klukshu River is to be included.

May this be given your consideration, and if approved, may the Surveys Branch be requested to conduct this survey during the summer of 1951.
