2. Any Crown land not lawfully held as heretofore mentioned situated within one mile of any part of the projected right of way of the proposed highway from Prince George via Summit Lake, Crooked and Parsnip Rivers, Finlay Forks and Peace Pass to Fort St. John:
3. Any Crown land not lawfully held as heretofore mentioned situated within one mile of any part of the projected right of way of the proposed highway from Prince George via Summit Lake, Crooked River, Misinchinka River and Pine Pass to Commotion Creek and Dawson Creek:
4. Any Crown land not lawfully held as heretofore mentioned situated within one mile of any part of the projected right of way of the proposed highway from Vanderhoof, via Fort St. James, Manson Creek, Finlay Forks and Peace Pass to Ft. St. John:
