We are forwarding to you under separate regis-
tered cover the original linen plans of sheets 3 and 4
together with 2 sepia linen prints of each of sheets 3
and 4 of the subject pipe line.

We cannot obtain the required linen opaque
prints without undue delay, therefore, we would appreciate
it if you would take it upon yourself to order these
prints and bill the Chief of Lands Division, Department
of Northern Affairs and National Resources at Ottawa.

We feel that the cost of sending Mr. Fox to
change the marking on the witness monument determining
the intersection of the pipe line with the British Columbia
Yukon Boundary shown on sheet 5 of the Right-of-way would
be unwarranted. Mr. Fox discovered the error on preparing
the returns and indicated the correct distance on the plan.

We would appreciate your acceptance of sheet 5
on the basis of the above explanation.
