 SUBJECT: Relocation of portion of Haines Cutoff Road

TO: Division Engineer, North Pacific Division, Corps of Engineers,

1. Attention is called to the original approval of \$55,000.00 for use by the Alaska Road Commission in preparation of plans and estimates for the "Relocation of portion of Haines Cutoff Road". This office approved and paid the bill in the amount of \$44,500.23 submitted by the Alaska Road Commission.

2. It is requested that an explanation be made and a justification be provided for the excess cost of the survey above the original approval, in the amount of \$55,000.00. It is further requested that a statement be supplied as to whether this latest Form 1080 is the final bill or whether there are other charges to be made.

3. Representatives of the Alaska Road Commission made statements while in Washington on business that the survey was completed early in the year. Under these circumstances it is not understood how there can be charges made for the period 21 September 1953 thru 13 December 1953.

4. The Standard Form 1080 is returned without action pending receipt of further data as requested above.
