Feedback on YMEP

The 2023 YMEP has generated 2 very good bulk sample results that should help Gimlex make an option deal and have a lot more work done on Veronica Bench soon. In the recent past we have optioned 2 of our other placer properties at Dominion and Indian River after completing YMEP auger drilling projects, and both were mined by the optionors. YMEP and now YMEP funding has provided valuable help with quite a number of our projects over the years and we have been able to sell some quartz claims as well. Also, we are very thankful for the professional help from your staff geologist..

This year at Veronica we had unforeseen difficulty getting started because of high water on Dominion Creek ford, and then more delays when we had to bring in another excavator from Indian River, only to find the 2022 test pits that were left open for future sampling had a lot of pooled water, and were useless for bulk sampling. We had to excavate all new pits for bulk sampling. We had difficulty finding suitable short term help and had to use 3 diamond drill helpers from Kluane Drilling. We also missed having Jeff Bond visit, and had to return later to have a visit with Jeff. By then we were pretty much on budget but Jeff suggested trying for a deeper bulk sample which we did with our larger PC400 excavator in late August After that we decided to backfill and reclaim all of the YMEP 22-003 and 23-024 trenches and disturbed areas while the PC400 was on site,because we had seen that pits left open pooled water andwere not very useful for future sampling.



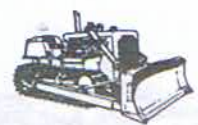
