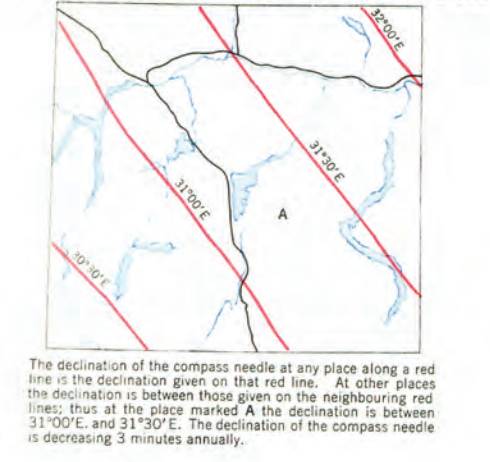

TEN THOUSAND METRE UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR GRID ZONE B

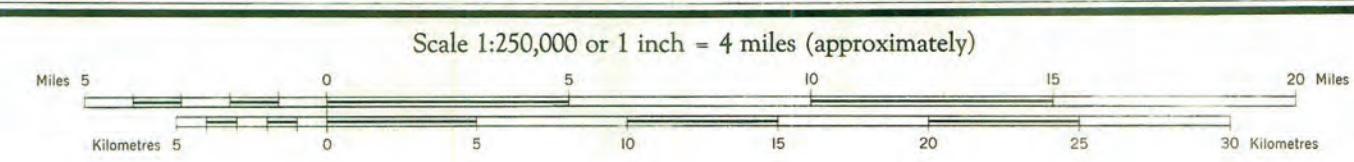
