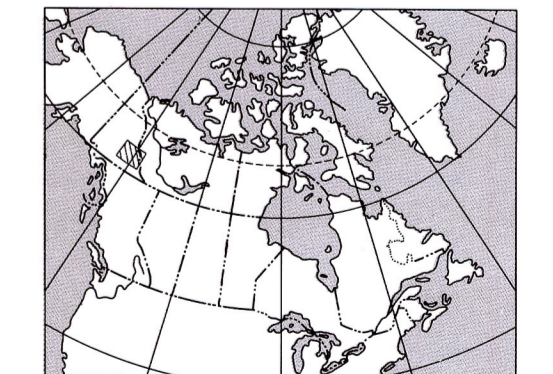
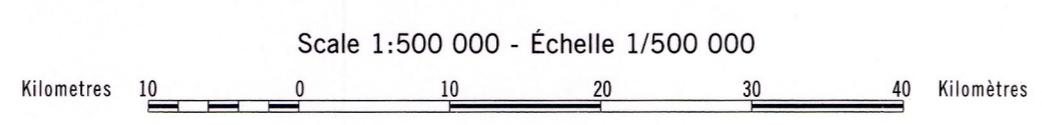


Figure 30. Ice-flow and ice-source areas



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
