

Figure 73. Three interpretations of the Mink Complex [original figure]: (A) Mink Complex is considered as basement raised diapirically during shortening, so that detachment continued at the top during its rise.

(B) Mink Complex is shown as an old core complex from which cover was tectonically stripped (during the Devonian). The core complex and overthrust allochthonous rocks were detached from their basement in the Late Cretaceous.

(C) Mink Complex is interpreted as a distinct lower slice of the allochthonous rocks.
