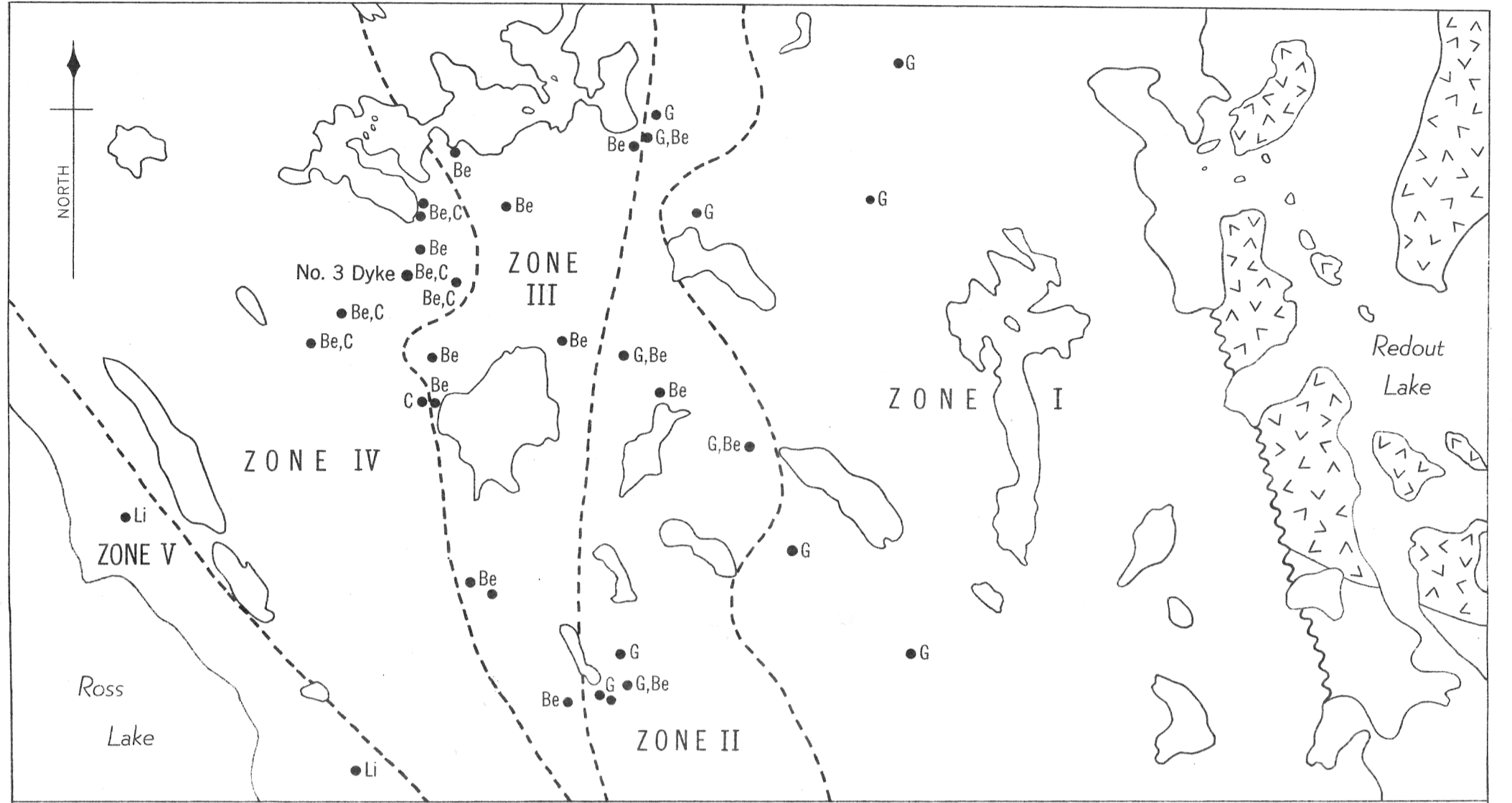

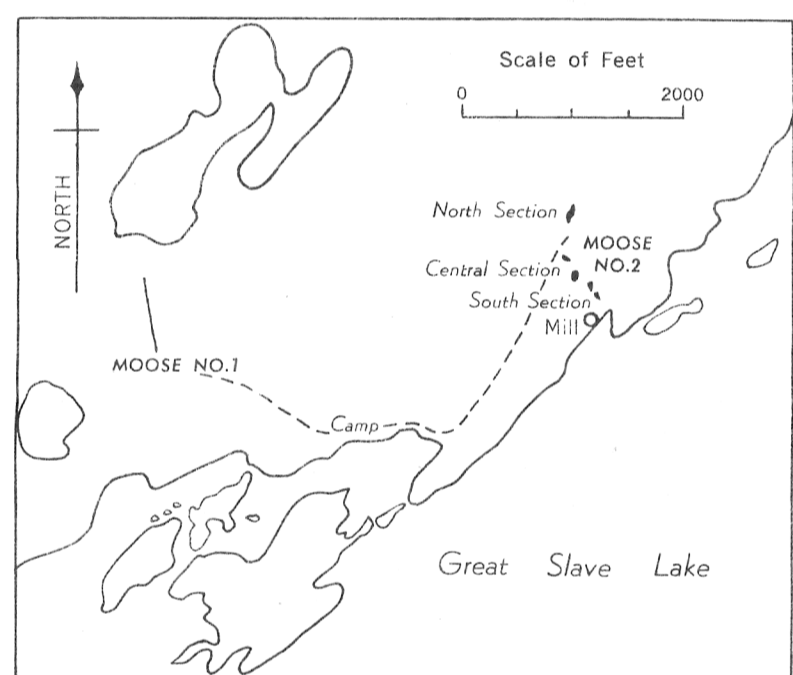

Sketch-map, showing location of Best Bet pegmatite, north of Hearne Channel, Great Slave Lake

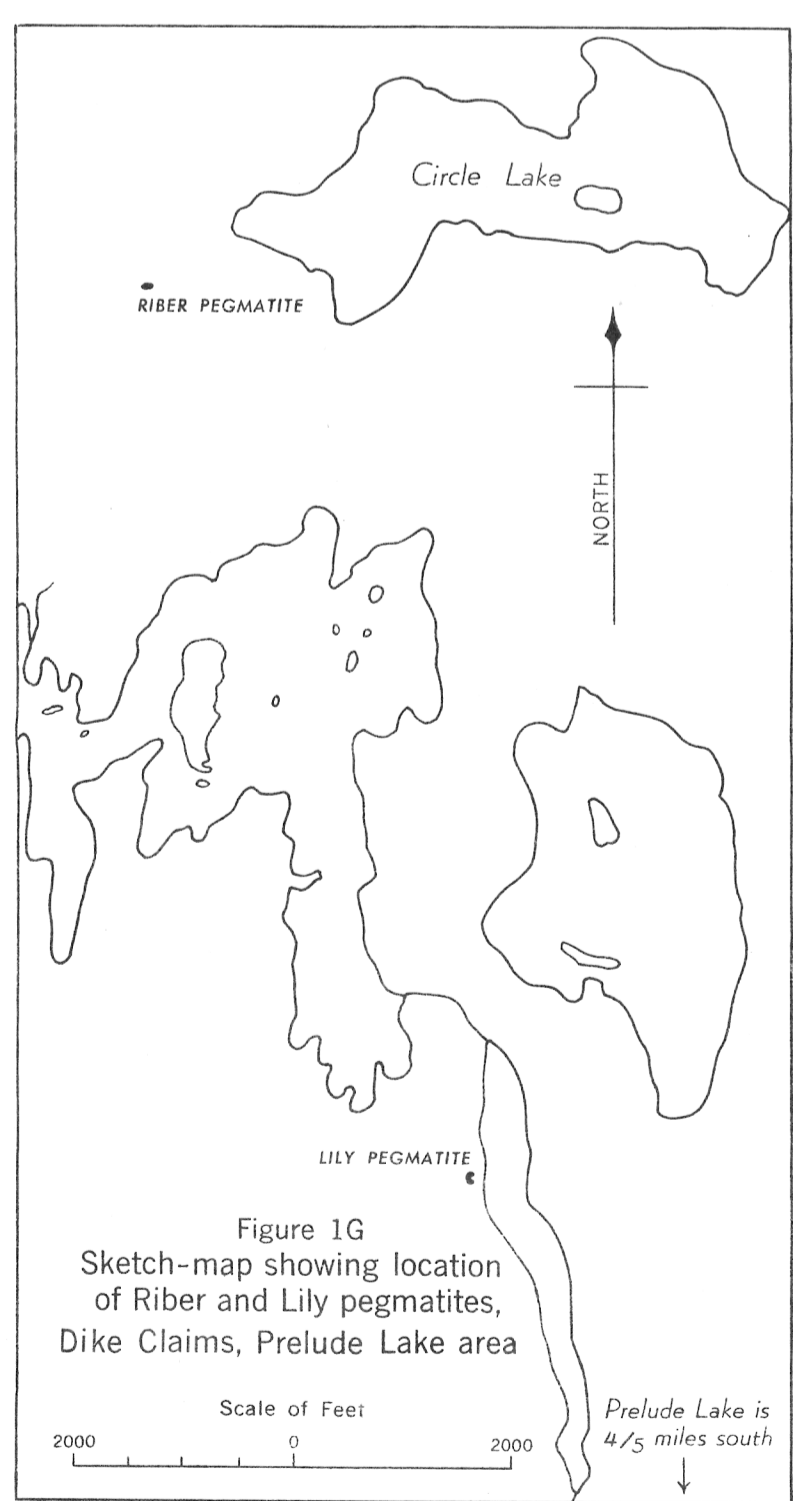

Sketch-map showing location of Riber and Lily pegmatites, Dike Claims, Prelude Lake area

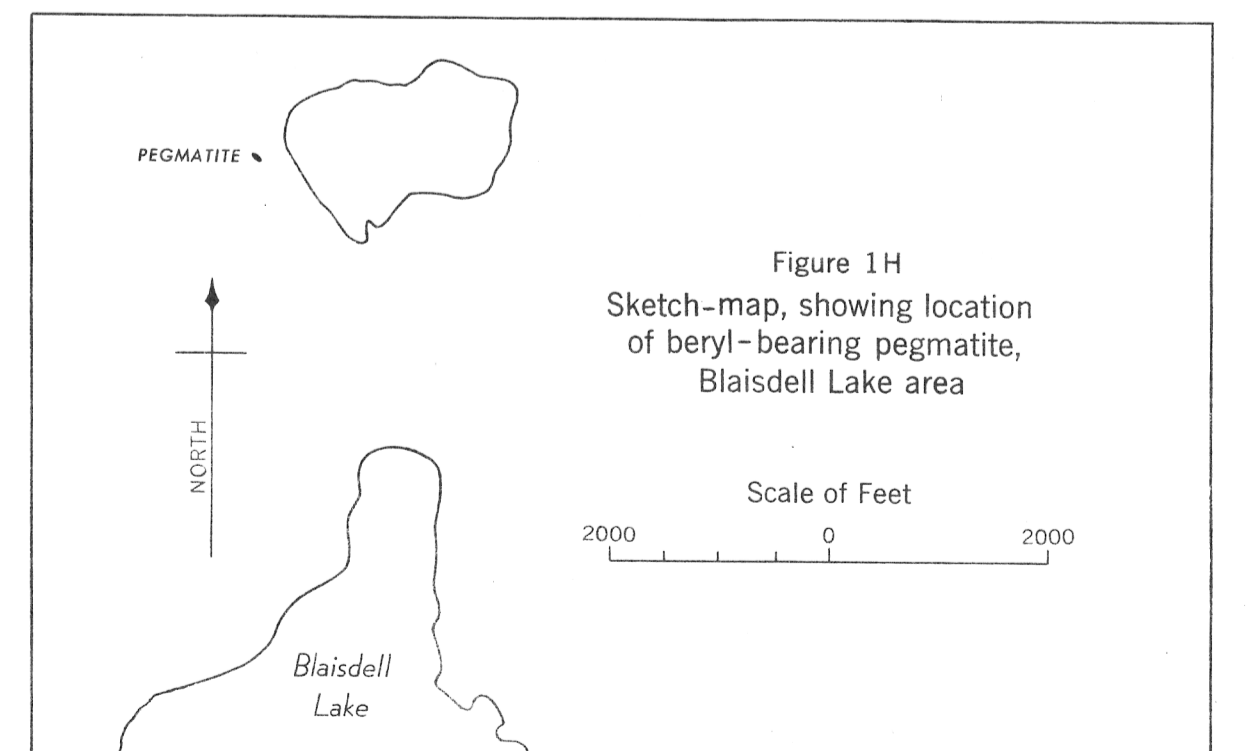

Sketch-map, showing location of beryl-bearing pegmatite, Blaisdell Lake area

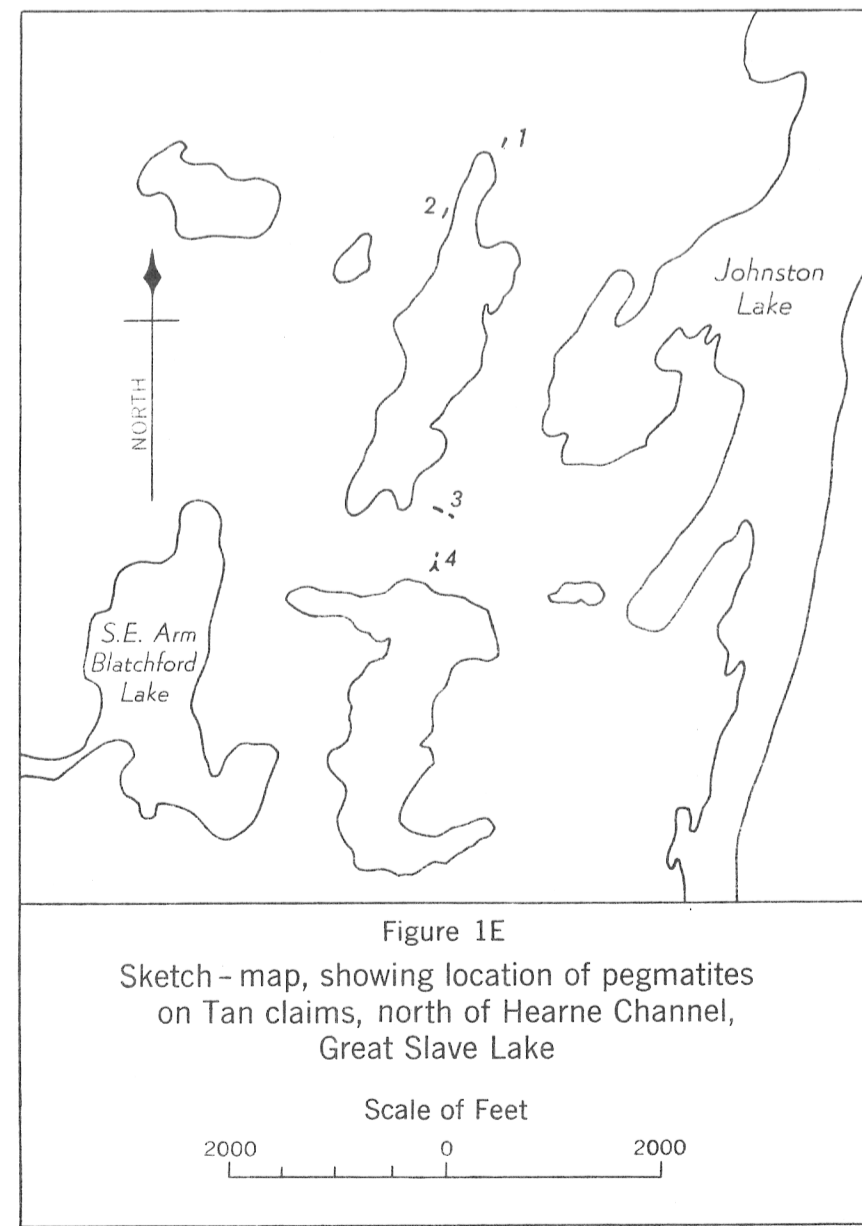

Sketch-map, showing location of pegmatites on Tan claims, north of Hearne Channel, Great Slave Lake

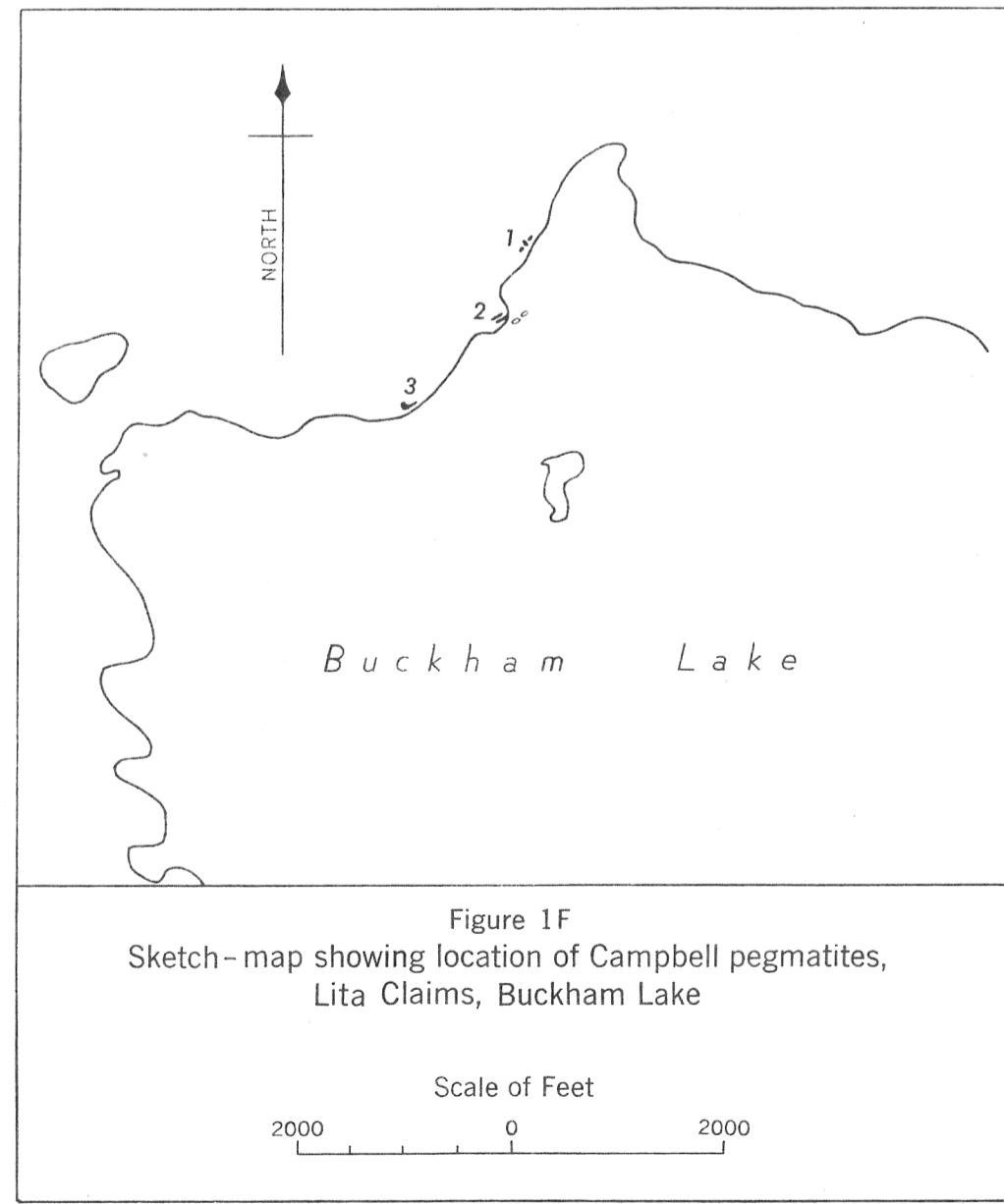
