

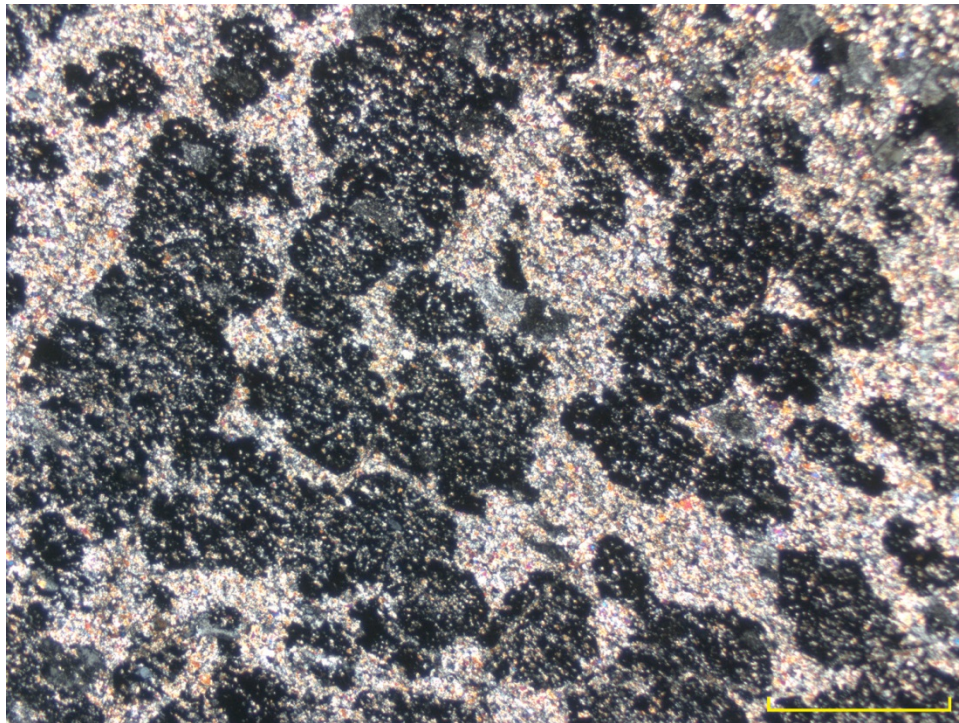

This rock shows equant, 0.5-0.7mm patches of feldspar in quartz and probably just coarser feldspar in a groundmass of 0.05mm grains of perhaps either sericite or smectite. An irregular vein, 0.25mm wide, is of feldspar. Slightly undulatory, but sub-parallel cracks traverse the rock, 1-2mm apart (no filling was recognisable). This may be a rhyolite with micropoikilitic texture.

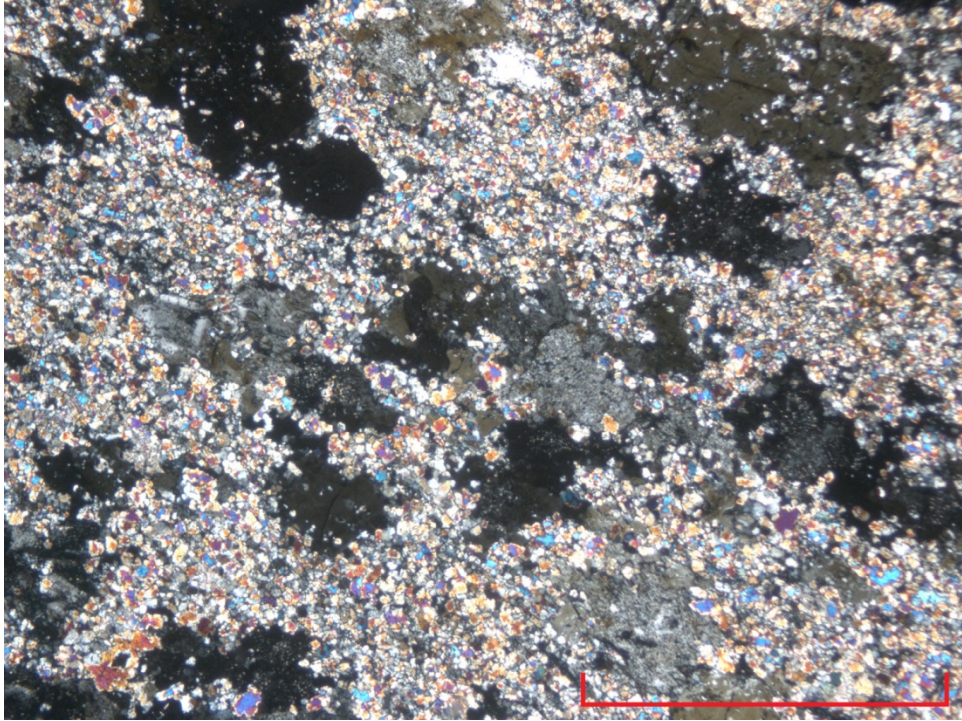
FA7-2,5xp shows a general view – probably micropoikilitic texture

FA7-5,0xp shows slightly finer-grained material

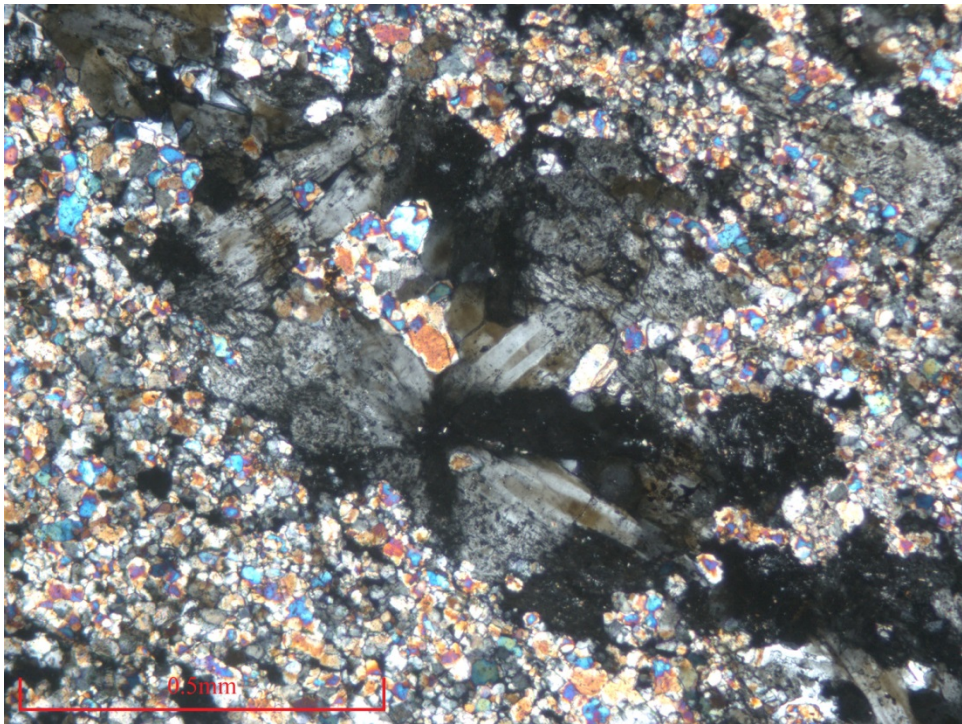
FA7-10xp shows a vein filled with feldspar (probably plagioclase)
